What business did I have spending my travel money, even though it was money that I had saved for years, to go on an expensive vacation prior to my wedding, not the honeymoon, just a trip to see my daughter. The fears were intense as Covid was rearing its ugly head again and family members from across the country were making their plans to come to Los Angeles for our wedding. What if either of us got sick and had to cancel the wedding? Worse, what if we got sick at my unvaccinated daughter's house and had to carry those resentments between us? What if we just got sick on the airplane because people were not masking and eating together in a crowded interior location? The fears were intense, and they were not unfounded.

"Unencumbered by fear" ...to me this means that we live with fear. We don't live in a bubble; however, fear does not dictate our actions. We have fears - we use those fears to take adequate precautions and we allow ourselves to have the prosperity that has been promised to us by our higher power. I had the money; we took the precautions, and we thoughtfully and carefully had a prosperous trip and a wonderful debt-free visit with my daughter and my son-in-law in Italy.



I prayed and asked god for help on a daily basis. I asked god for help with everything I did all day long. I wonder if god thinks I am a bit of a cry baby? I ask god for help with everything - my video games, my relationships, my art projects, my daily plans, and my sore throat. I guess I never really stop talking to god. 
