

Positions require that you attend the Service Board and Intergroup Meetings every 3rd Saturday of the month.


The Meetings start at 9am and 11am respectively.





The governing body of SCDA is the Intergroup. Each meeting is urged to send a representative to the Intergroup meeting, the third Saturday of each month. Currently these meetings are being held on the Internet, via zoom.com. The Service Board exists to carry out the policies determined by the Intergroup.
